

Ordinance No. 2016-10

The Town Board of the Town of Eastman, Crawford County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That, pursuant to Wis. Stat. Section 60.30(1e)(a), the office of the Clerk/Treasurer (combined office) shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the town board.

The term of office for the appointed position(s) shall be set by the town board, but may not exceed 3 years per Section 60.30(1e)(c). The town board may re-appoint the officer for additional terms. However, removal by the town board during a given term of office may only be for "cause" as defined under Section 17.001 and required by Section 60.30(1e)(f).

This ordinance is subject to approval by the town electors in a referendum, which is hereby called by the Town Board to be held on November 8, 2016. The referendum question shall be:


"Shall the person holding the office of town clerk and town treasurer (combined) in the Town of Eastman be appointed by the town board?"

The salary of the appointed position(s) shall be set by the town board and may not be reduced during the term of office.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its town board passage, notice after passage per Section 60.80 and also its referendum approval by the town electors as required by Section 60.30(1e)(b).
